

Once Upon An American Dream During an era not too long ago, in a land some of us still recognize, my father began his journey to secure a better future for his family.


Armed with not much more than the necessity to succeed, Rene Olguin Hobart left his family in Mexico and began working as a stockboy in Stillwater, MN.



Saltillo Flooring

Saltillo Natural – This is the traditional classic Saltillo look, where variations of color range from terra-cottas to golden tones creating a beautiful unique pattern on the floor.

Saltillo Rojo – This Saltillo has predominately terra-cottas and few golden tones.

Saltillo Manganese – The mineral manganese is mixed with the traditional Saltillo clay transforming the tile into dark and light brown tones, also variegated.







Saltillo tile is named for the town in Mexico where it is made. The tile has been made using the same methods that were handed down by settlers from Spain hundreds of years ago. The area around Saltillo has the proper mix of clay, climate, and dedicated workers to produce one of the world's most popular tiles.

Saltillo tiles are not merely "sundried", although sun drying is one step in its production, Reeso Saltillo tiles are kiln fired. The way in which these handmade tiles are stacked and positioned in the kiln produces their natural shading and range in color from light blonde to a dark amber. The off color striping is caused by the overlapping of tiles when they are stacked in the kiln.
